As the landscape continues to change and we find our way to maneuver through the current situation we again appreciate everyone's support and understanding. While there is always speculation and rumor I do want to tell you all that we are dealing with several staff members with positive Covid19 cases. At this time those cases have created a very large exposure and required quarantines for our high school students.

Due to this large exposure – the students of grades 7-12 will start remote learning tomorrow - running through Friday, October 2nd. Our goal is to be back to “in-person” learning on Monday, October 5th. Mr. Rathje will be sending an email to all students today indicating their remote learning schedule, zoom links for their teachers and other related information. Students will be required to zoom into their classes each and every day.

Tomorrow we will be welcoming back our K-6 elementary students. All K-6 students are required to wear a mask to enter the building. We will have masks available. As mentioned and explained yesterday, masking allows us the ability to greatly control and reduce required quarantines.

Tomorrow is also our first day to offer free breakfasts and lunches to all students. There is no need to fill out an application, as this is a federal government program that will run through December 31st.

As I stated yesterday, we want and need our kids in school. Achieving that goal will require everyone to work together for our students and staff. We will continue to provide you with updates during this challenging time.
