Dear Parents,

As local and state Covid-19 cases increase, we want to send out a few reminders to help you and your family stay safe during the Thanksgiving holiday. While many of you have already experienced or know someone who has experienced Covid-19 it is important to remember that every person reacts differently. - The school may require the results or a doctor's note in some cases
- Students may return to school after a timeline has been established
